Alexander Knauf, born in 1974, is Speaker of the General Partners of the Knauf Group. The Knauf Group is active in over 90 countries and operates more than 320 plants and over 85 raw materials processing plants throughout the world (2024: € 15.6 billion revenue, approx. 43,500 employees).

After obtaining his master's degree, Alexander Knauf worked as a consultant for Roland Berger GmbH. He then moved to Chicago to work for the United States Gypsum Corporation.

In 2004, Alexander Knauf took over the group management for the region Northern Europe within the Knauf Group. He was in charge of the region Central Europe from 2012 until January 2013, when he was appointed to the position of General Partner of the Knauf Group. Alexander Knauf has been Speaker of the General Partners since January 2022. Knauf is married and has four children.
